DEFINITION	 The designation allows a variety of "clean" light industrial, production, distribution, and commercial uses that typically involve physical assembly/reshaping of finished materials and/or retail sales that are incidental to an industrial use. Produces limited impacts on nearby properties, such as noise, gas, odor, or vibration. Buildings can vary in size from small-scale industrial flex uses to large floorplate buildings. 	 The designation allows for a wide variety of manufacturing, warehouse, and distribution uses that typically involve a transformation of extracted or raw materials. Toxic, hazardous, or explosive materials may be produced or used in large quantities Could cause impacts on nearby properties, such as noise, gas, odor, dust, or vibration. New uses should be located away from residential areas and new residential uses should not be allowed nearby.
